



The Master Gardener Program

What's required?

Graduate from 50 hour training course on home horticulture offered at Bryan and Marshall County OSU Extension Centers (\$90 course fee, or \$105 for a couple sharing materials). Course meets one day a week for nine weeks, alternating between Durant and Madill.

Volunteer at least 40 hours of community service back to the County Extension Horticulture education program in the following calendar year. This may include teaching workshops, garden club presentations, community beautification projects, volunteering at the Extension Office, County Fair, Garden Show, etc. (Must be approved by the Extension Educator)

Maintain and submit a log of your volunteer hours to the County Extension Educator at the end of the year.

For Advanced Master Gardener status, continue to complete at least 20 hours of approved community service and 20 hours of continuing education annually.

When can I start?

The next class will be offered this fall. Dates are September 20, 27, October 4, 11, 18, 25, November 1, 8, and 15. Each class will meet from 9:00 am to approximately 3:30 pm except for the tour to the OSU Arboretum and Oklahoma Gardening TV Studio Garden on September 27 or October 4.

Fill out and submit the attached form to the Bryan County Extension Office. Space is limited, so applications will be accepted based on date application is received and a personal interview. The course fee will be due on or before August 15th.
