Use the green “Member’s Record” folder **\$1.75 each**

The *Current Year in 4-H* is the number of years you **have been** in 4-H **PLUS** your current year in 4-H

(Example: I have been in 4-H for 3 years and this is my 4th year, so I will put a **4** in that space)

Table of Contents

- Provides sections and separation of your record to make it easier to read and teaches organization skills.

Project Objectives

- Obtain individual project objectives from 4-H Leader
 - **COPY THE OBJECTIVES FROM THE INSIDE OF 4-H AWARDS MANUAL**
- Show new things learned and provide date (mm-yyyy) to keep the record in a chronological order.
- List the work done in project – **detail will help your record keeping**

4-H Story

- What 4-H meant to you this year.
- What you did positive and negative (what was learned from it!)

“accumulative_records.doc” Help

Accumulative Records

- First time Record Keepers need to obtain the Accumulative_records.doc file and begin their record keeping
- All other 4-H’ers add the necessary pages to the accumulative_records.doc file.

Pictures in 4th section

- Pictures of what you did in your project
- Optional but recommended.
